- 4. It would be best if you attend all sessions of this conference from opening to closing however, if you are unable to attend all, it is expected that you attend at least your own session.
- 5. Your session chairs and discussants are copied to this email. It would be worthwhile to connect with them and best if you may forward them a one-page executive summary of your paper.
- 6. You will need to effectively manage the presentation time please note, no author will be given more than 15 minutes, so if you do not keep the timings under consideration, the session chairs will have to intervene, and you may not be able to complete your presentation. - 8. Questions & Answers will be allowed at the end of all presentations and each presenter will be given 10-12 minutes for questions and answers.
- 9. Please join the session 20 minutes in advance and test your PowerPoint slides to avoid doing this once the session is underway.
- 10. Lastly, kindly note your papers were peer-reviewed and a lot of effort was put in the review process and the selection of your paper. As a gesture we also waived off registration fee for all participants. So, it is expected that all of you participate.
